## **WHAT WILL YOU NEED...**

The graduates who have done well with the business already had some knowledge of, and interest in, BREEAM. So, this is preferred (though you don't need to have used it in a job yet).

This is very much about working with buildings, not the broader environmental field. In terms of degree type, something Construction, Geography, or Architecture, Engineering, or Project Management related, would be ideal. But others will be considered if you have some interest in BREEAM.

You'll need good time management and organisational skills; in addition to good problem solving skills.

Due to the difficulties involved in relocation, you will need to already be within commutable distance of Bristol; or specifically looking to move there, and easily able to do so due to connections. Within 20 miles or so is ok. The business offers flexible, hybrid, working, so once you are trained up you should, be able to work from home for part of the time.
